



Q. Can I use it every day?

A. Yes. A gradual, natural-looking color will result after about one week of continued use. After the first week, it should be applied two to three times a week to maintain a subtle tan. connect with your customers build relationships by prioritizing



Have you ever looked at your customer list ready to make some connections and then quickly lost motivation? You're not alone. That's what happened last fall to Independent Future Executive Senior Sales Director Vicki Piccirilli of Tampa, Fla. "Thinking about calling 150 customers was so overwhelming that I didn't call anyone," Vicki, a member of the Independent National Sales Director Cathy Littlejohn Area, shares. And those customers certainly weren't calling her.

During this time, Vicki also realized that while the Mary Kay® product line is vast, most of her customers only purchased select items. "I knew I had to somehow make my customers think of me whenever they needed anything I offer - instead of going to the drugstore to buy it."

That's when Vicki decided to put into action a customer service concept she learned about in a previous career. To get started, Vicki used the "Customer Groups" function in myCustomers® to group all of her customer into Groups A, B and C.

group a

In Group A, she placed the names of women with whom she feels a strong connection. "When I read Group A names, they make me smile and brighten up. They are the women I want to spend more time with," Vicki says. For Vicki, this group numbers about 40, and she recommends keeping this group anywhere from 10 to 40.

Vicki calls everyone in Group A inviting them to coffee, breakfast or lunch. "I let them know this invitation is a simple thank-you for being my customer and about reconnecting with them," Vicki explains. "I truly go into each meeting without any other motives. It's all about building relationships."

Group A also is set up to receive all Preferred Customer Program mailings, including The Look and Month 2 mailers; e-mails and MKeCards®; special thank-you gifts that are personally delivered throughout the year; and phone calls about every three months to keep the connection flowing.

In Group C, Vicki placed those who make minimum purchases, such as only a few lipsticks per year. Group C receives the Beaut-e-News™ e-newsletter and a call every six months.

group b

In Group B, Vicki placed the names of customers who order a few times a year but aren't as strongly connected to her. This group numbers about 70.

While Group B does not receive invitations for a meal or coffee, Vicki continues their Preferred Customer Program mailings and calls them once each quarter. Group B also receives MKeCards® and the Beaut-e-News™ e-newsletter.

the results

After Vicki first began meeting with the women in Group A last November, she was astounded by the results. Without ever being asked, most Group A women placed an order on the spot or booked a class. From Group A connections, Vicki booked about 20 classes and added three new team members. To her amazement, Group A customers requested more contact from her.

Group A connections also created the full-circle momentum for more bookings and additional teambuilding opportunities.

From Group A, B and C contacts, Vicki estimates that her sales have increased more than 25 percent. She attributes that to increased customer contact getting her "face" in front of her customers on a regular basis. She's also rejuvenated her personal enthusiasm for customer service now that she has a manageable plan. "I'm so invigorated now that I have a plan for building relationships – the aspect of this business I love so much," Vicki says.

Every few months, Vicki reviews names in Group A to determine if she would like to meet with anyone in that group again. She's also found that each group fluctuates. For example, she may decide that Group A women who elect not to meet with her should move to Group B. And some new women she meets are added to Group A and so forth.

Others in the Littlejohn Area have adopted Vicki's customer service plan and are seeing similar results. It could be just the plan to keep you focused and motivated to increase your customer service goals!






Now, looking back, I believe with all my heart that God used my difficult circumstances to perform some much-needed "heart surgery" on me. Having been an Independent Sales Director for only six years, I already had achieved so many Mary Kay successes, and to be honest, I enjoyed the spotlight. But it had all been about me. At Seminar 2007, I suddenly saw that this Mary Kay journey was not about me but rather about the women I lead. I learned to love the Independent Beauty Consultants in my unit for who they are, not for where they could take me. I even learned to trust again. In my most broken state, Seminar took the limits off my thinking and breathed life back into me. The members of my unit and I have come to see that success, sometimes, is to just keep going.

hen Independent Sales **Director Karen Mitterling** Johnson, of Riverton, Utah, in the Independent National Sales Director Tammy Crayk Area said "I do" in 1980, she put on a new perspective along with her wedding ring. A city gal from Fresno, Calif., Karen married a horticulturist, Brent, who had a love of the land deep in his genes and a wide-open dream in his heart. Although Brent's dream was not her dream, Karen committed herself to helping him bring his vision to life. There was just one cloud on their harmonious horizon: Karen and Brent desperately wanted children, but infertility had left them alone. The couple decided to adopt and brought two biracial sons into their caring home.

But providence saw an even bigger picture, and soon Karen was pregnant with triplets. Their surprise-package daughters only multiplied their bliss, and the tight-knit family felt comfortably complete. Her longtime desire to be a stay-at-home mom had become a reality, and Karen, a former teacher, believed she had retired from the working world for good. They moved to a 90-acre spread near a small Pennsylvania community, where eventually greenhouses dotted their fertile farmland and crops of colorful field mums bobbed in the sunny breezes.

Sudden Impact

Then one day their fairy tale took a cruel turn, and the unthinkable happened. In just one day, suddenly and without warning, an aneurysm took Brent and his dream. Close on the heels of nearly paralyzing grief came harsh reality, and Karen found herself - a widow with five children - confronted with a lifechanging decision. "First of all, I was no farmer," she confesses. "Maintaining greenhouses was completely outside my comfort zone. But I now had to earn a living for six people. Death has a way of shaking up your plans. Being a stayat-home mom was my passion, but now that door seemed closed and locked." Life insurance didn't cover the family's long-term needs, and Karen says her future seemed impossible. "I felt utterly lost and hopeless," she

recalls. "I wasn't excited about resurrecting my teaching degree, but I was willing to do what was necessary to feed and clothe my children."

Karen felt she was being drawn back to Utah, where she had received her teaching degree. There she could reactivate her expired certificate, and she hoped to find work immediately. She had a brother in the Salt Lake City area, and she knew he would give her the support she needed for her family's transition.

She was grateful, and she sensed God had a plan for her new life.

An Unexpected Harvest of Blessings

Thousands of miles from where she and Brent had sown, cultivated and lost one life, Karen found herself taking steps to plant a new one. She still felt disappointed about giving up her dream to stay home with her kids, but she was reconciled to going it alone. Brent's memory remained tender, and besides, she was too busy to think about meeting someone and remarrying. Not long after she settled in, however – as though the tapestry of her life had unfurled a new thread - she met Carl Johnson, a recent widower with eight children. In time, they fell in love and married. "Carl's youngest boys were 12 and 9, my two sons were 13 and 10, and my three girls were 8," Karen

explains. "We had a litter pack of seven kids at home, all within a five-year span. The arrangement sounds crazy, but Carl and I discovered it was right for us. It felt so good to heal and mend our losses together, and to help our children heal as well."

And changes were developing in Karen's work life too. After a few years of teaching, her school district recognized her abilities by asking her to become one of their literacy coaches. She undertook a master's degree program focused on elementary reading and coaching, a new academic dimension that increased her sense of worth. Then in March 2005, Karen's daughter-in-law, a brand-new Mary Kay Independent Beauty Consultant, asked if she could practice team

> building with Karen. "She was just getting started, and she wanted to pretend she was approaching the scariest woman she knew," Karen says with a laugh. "She assured me that I wasn't scary, but it was scary for her to ask. I agreed. Later, when Carl and I watched the Consider the Possibilities video, he got enthusiastic and encouraged me to 'go for it.' His belief must have been catching.

Before that, I had had no interest in

sales. After all, I was on the road to new-found success in education, going to grad school, parenting seven teenagers at home and working full time as a coach. Who would have thought it was reasonable to add something to all that? But I signed my Independent Beauty Consultant Agreement hoping to make about \$400 per month so that my oldest son could serve a church mission. With our bundle of kids and the expenses of extracurricular activities, we were maxed out financially."

In the beginning, Karen had her doubts about whether "this Mary Kay thing" would work out. But meeting Independent Senior Sales Director Allison Cheney enabled her to imagine even greater possibilities. "I thought, 'She's driving a Mary Kay pink Cadillac Career Car, and at 28, she's making more money than I am. If she can do it, I could too." Within a few months, Karen discovered she was successful at selling product. She surpassed her \$400 goals by fitting in skin

care classes and team-building appointments around school, soccer, dance lessons, doctor visits, etc. And the best was yet to come. "It wasn't until Seminar that I conceived the idea that women can be really successful when they become teachable and are willing to do the work," she says. "What did it for me was seeing at Seminar that there are more than just a few women who are successful in this business. There are *many!* One woman went across the stage in her wheelchair and received a diamond ring. I mentally tallied my excuses and came up with none. Kids, graduate school, full-time work? Even with all that, I can do it, I thought. After all, excuses are what keep us from realizing our dreams. It was then that I gave myself permission to dream again. It was then that the seeds of belief were planted again."

That fall Karen entered Sales Director-in-Qualification. "Right after Seminar, I started grabbing every opportunity I could," she says. "I participated in Independent National Sales Director Tammy Crayk's challenge to do Power Starts for a solid 12 months. If I could do a Power Start consistently, everything would fall into place, and I knew I would move forward more smoothly. I began to resurrect my little girl dreams of traveling, building my perfect home, staying home with my children again - just to name a few. My passion was building. I earned the use of my first Mary Kay Career Car while balancing my family, graduate school and coaching, and I've continued to improve my processes. My Mary Kay business provides ultimate flexibility."

Ducks, and Duties, in a Row

So just how does she make it all work with so many family and school obligations? Karen quickly gives credit to her not-so-secret helpers. "Carl's been an inspiring supporter from day one. He saw in me what I couldn't see in myself," she says. "He's my biggest cheerleader and sounding board. By day he's a project manager for a construction company. By night he's a taxi driver and computer guru for whatever I need. Plus, he comes to all our weekly success meetings!" In addition, the Johnson family regularly sits down and constructs a plan sheet on a

board mounted in the kitchen. There, chores are delegated, meals are assigned, product deliveries are arranged and even some office duties are parceled out. Karen's eyes twinkle mischievously. "Doing those plan-sheet honey-dos are how my kids earn all those dance lessons, soccer paraphernalia, car insurance - we have lots of car drivers in our house! and anything else they need. It's a family effort."

Karen confesses a few other efficiency secrets: She uses every break at her school job to make phone calls; she uses an earpiece for working in the car while waiting to pick up the kids. She multitasks five minutes here and five minutes there, "instead of waiting for a chunk of time, which would never appear!" She reserves one night per week for her unit meetings and another for skin care classes. She works her business all day on Saturday. "Failure was not, and is not, an option," she says. "Having the freedom to work my Mary Kay business and still be at home as needed, it's almost a miracle. Now that flexibility has allowed my goals and dreams to truly flourish, my passion to grow my Mary Kay business has grown all the more."

Working Her Plan

With all her success, how does she deal with a setback? "I'm a super results-oriented person, and when results don't come as planned, I can become discouraged. During these times, I seek the wisdom of my Independent National Sales Director and Independent Senior Sales Director, my husband and others I respect and with whom I'd like to trade places. God is a very important part of my life, my ultimate source of inspiration and comfort. Thankfully, I've learned to trust the process of moving forward in



my Mary Kay business, which has given me great tools for life. This journey is truly one of personal growth. 45th Anniversary Pioneer Spotlight

Following Her Leader's Example

Independent Executive Senior Sales Director Mary Sharon Howell of Daytona Beach, Fla., in the Ruby Go Give Area, was a former teacher and "military wife" when she agreed to the Mary Kay opportunity in 1972. She and her family were living in Hawaii, and although Mary Kay Ash hadn't yet visited the islands, Mary Sharon immediately made a connection with her message. "All I could say at the time -



and today, these many years later - is WOW!
